The Count Me In Puppet Programme

All children with a disability want is for others to see them, first and foremost, as a person – a person with desires, dreams and aspirations in life – just like everyone else.

The way we react towards people with disabilities is very often due to our experiences when we were children. At Kidz Aware, we believe that if we can help children feel comfortable with and have a greater understanding about children with disabilities, we can have a very positive impact in ensuring that as people go through life together, a greater equality of opportunity and inclusion will exist for all.

Kidz Aware delivers the Count Me In Puppet Programme in a way that appeals to children by using our seven child size puppets, our Count Me In song and through interaction.

The Lets Prevent Bullying Puppet Programme

The Lets Prevent Bullying Puppet Programme helps both children and adults gain information about children's experiences of being bullied and also helps children develop personal safety skills.

The programme features four endearing, multi-racial, child size puppets that portray children with and without disabilities. The puppets have been proven to be a comfortable medium through which to teach children about the sensitive issue of bullying.

The show addresses:

- The definitions of bullying and personal safety
- How to get help
- The need for children to be able to talk about being bullied
- How to support others who are the victims of bullying

We would dearly welcome the chance to visit you to deliver this educational, interactive and fun programme with our family of puppets; all with different disabilities and representing the cultural diversity that exists within our communities.
